

Note on the index

This volume offers two indexes. The first index gives an alphabetical list of authors with their different scientific contributions published in *Scientiarum Historia*. The second index is ordered according to subject-matter. While the use of the first index is obvious, the use of the second may ask for some clarification.

The index to subject-matter is only meant to assist the reader of *Scientiarum Historia* in his search for specific topics. The index thus gives the names of the principal scientists and of the main subjects discussed in the periodical's contributions. It is by no means an exhaustive catalogue containing every single proper name or specific subject-matter mentioned or touched upon in the periodical. Detailed indexes of the first ten issues have been compiled by Jozef Lieshoudt, *Scientiarum Historia (Antwerpen) 1 (1959) – X (1968)*, in *Tijdschrift voor bibliografie, Bibliografische monografieën* 12, Keerbergen, 1981.

The numbers used in this index refer to the articles' order in the first index.
